5 events have been carried out within this project:

Event 1

Participation: The event involved 110 citizens, including 61 participants from the city of Orte (**Italy**), 4 participants from the city of Svodín (**Slovakia**), 14 participants from the city of Dali (**Cyprus**), 6 participants from the city of Panevėžys (**Lithuania**), 6 participants from the city of Agia (**Greece**), 4 participants from the city of Warsaw (**Poland**), 3 participants from the city of Söderkulla/Lahti (**Finland**), 3 participants from the city of Filipstad (**Sweden**), 3 participants from the city of Curtis (**Spain**) and 6 participants from the city of Irig (**Serbia**).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Orte/Canepina (**Italy**), from 06/09/2021 to 10/09/2021.

Short description: The aim of the event was to introduce the partnership and the project and to discuss the methodology and the planned activities. Brainstorming on misleading information and civic engagement. Meeting with public authorities and visit to local associations to allow the exchange of best practices and dissemination of the project. Debate on the spread of fake news linked to Europe, which allowed an open discussion and active contribution of the participants to the main project themes. Workshop and Debate Session "Civil Society Organisation and their role in an ever changing world". Cultural visit – Viterbo, Civita di Bagnoregio and Rome.

Event 2

Participation: The event involved 106 citizens, including 11 participants from the city of Orte (**Italy**), 3 participants from the city of Svodín (**Slovakia**), 4 participants from the city of Dali (**Cyprus**), 4 participants from the city of Panevėžys (**Lithuania**), 70 participants from the city of Agia (**Greece**), 2 participants from the city of Warsaw (**Poland**), 2 participants from the city of Söderkulla/Lahti (**Finland**), 2 participants from the city of Filipstad (**Sweden**), 3 participants from the city of Curtis (**Spain**) and 5 participants from the city of Irig (**Serbia**).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Agia (**Greece**), from 30/06/2022 to 04/07/2022.

Short description: The activities carried out during the event in Greece were as follows: Visit to local associations to allow best practices exchange and dissemination of CASE Project. Seminar and round tables about the Project's theme, objectives, priorities and activities: "EU values, history and understanding of the policy-making process among citizens at local and international level". Seminar about the European opportunities, such as the Europe For Citizens/CERV programme, the Erasmus+ programme, the ESC programme, etc.

Event 3

Participation: The event involved 109 citizens, including 8 participants from the city of Orte (**Italy**), 2 participants from the city of Svodín (**Slovakia**), 72 participants from the city of Dali (**Cyprus**), 4 participants from the city of Panevėžys (**Lithuania**), 7 participants from the city of Agia (**Greece**), 4 participants from the city of Warsaw (**Poland**), 2 participants from the city of Söderkulla/Lahti (**Finland**), 2 participants from the city of Filipstad (**Sweden**), 4 participants from the city of Curtis (**Spain**) and 4 participants from the city of Irig (**Serbia**).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Dali (**Cyprus**), from 21/08/2022 to 25/08/2022.

Short description: The activities carried out during the event in Cyprus were as follows: Workshop on “Tools for active citizenship” and “Citizens panels methodology”. Round tables: “The role of activator: motivate others through non-formal edu tools”. Workshop: “How to draft recommendations and how to present specific information in a clear manner?” Guided cultural tour of Larnaka and Nikosia. Seminar: “Civil society organisations as a tool to contrast disruptive propaganda”.

Event 4

Participation: The event involved 111 citizens, including 11 participants from the city of Orte (**Italy**), 3 participants from the city of Svodín (**Slovakia**), 3 participants from the city of Dali (**Cyprus**), 4 participants from the city of Panevėžys (**Lithuania**), 2 participants from the city of Agia (**Greece**), 2 participants from the city of Warsaw (**Poland**), 76 participants from the city of Söderkulla/Lahti (**Finland**), 3 participants from the city of Filipstad (**Sweden**), 4 participants from the city of Curtis (**Spain**) and 3 participants from the city of Irig (**Serbia**).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Lahti (**Finland**), from 02/04/2023 to 06/04/2023.

Short description: The delegates have participated in Group works and debates, to allow the exchange of information at local and european level, exchanging ideas, practices and experiences related to the citizens' panels: “How to communicate the EU?”, “How to foster media literacy and correct use of information?”, “Participation of youth in CSO” and “How to be an active EU citizen?”. Debate session: session: “CSO as a tool to contrast disruptive propaganda - draft of recommendations and key practices”. Seminar on Finnish education system and Vocational education. Cultural visit to Helsinki and Söderkulla.

Event 5

Participation: The event involved 212 citizens, including 139 participants from the city of Orte (**Italy**), 12 participants from the city of Svodín (**Slovakia**), 13 participants from the city of Dali (**Cyprus**), 8 participants from the city of Panevėžys (**Lithuania**), 9 participants from the city of Agia (**Greece**), 4 participants from the city of Warsaw (**Poland**), 4 participants from the city of Söderkulla/Lahti (**Finland**), 5 participants from the city of Filipstad (**Sweden**), 8 participants from the city of Curtis (**Spain**) and 10 participants from the city of Irig (**Serbia**).

Location / Dates: The event took place in Giove/Gallese (**Italy**), from 22/06/2023 to 26/06/2023.

Short description: The aim of the event was to conclude the project and to present the project results. Moreover, the Final International Conference was held to officially conclude the CASE project, involving all the delegates and direct participants in reporting the activities and results so be active part in the dissemination of CASE. Fishbowl conversation to give the floor to citizens, PA and stakeholders to exchange their experience and thoughts about the project. The participants were also involved in self assessment activities to evaluate achievement of skills and participation to Project. The delegates participated in a cultural tour of the city of Orvieto and of the Parco dei Mostri (“*Monster Park*”) in Bomarzo. Workshop and debates about Solidarity in times of crisis and Policrisis. Seminar: “Citizens participation and international crisis - the effect on the solidarity tissue at local level.”
